FORT LA REINE MUSEUM CORN MAZE

Location & Hours

The corn maze is open daily from August 14 - October 17, 2021 (8am-8pm)

It is located on the east side of the Museum grounds (2652 Saskatchewan Ave E, Portage la Prairie MB). Visitors may enter through the main gates, and park either in the main parking lot (if they are also visiting the museum), or in the right-side overflow parking lot.

Cost

Admission into the Corn Maze is by cash donation, a donation box is located on the entrance archway to the maze. It is emptied and deposited 3-4 times daily.

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Do I need to book in advance?** *No, booking in advance is not required.*
- 2. We want to avoid people, when is it less busy?** *Weekdays and mornings.*
- 3. Can I bring my dog/pets?** *Unfortunately pets are not permitted in the corn maze.*
- 4. How much should we donate for admission?** *\$3-\$5/person is recommended, as it helps us with maze maintenance costs and other public programs.*
- 5. Can we visit the Museum *and* go in the Corn Maze?** *Only when the museum is also open (please check our seasonal hours on our website)*
- 6. Is the corn edible?** *The corn variety that was planted is meant for livestock feed, and it is not for human consumption.*
- 7. Can I book the corn maze for private use/rentals?** *No, unfortunately the corn maze is meant to be accessible for everyone.*
